Danger of unnecessary Injury	Ensure that equipment is set up with adequate lighting and that the person setting up equipment has taken an on-site survey prior to setting up.	2	1	2	Ensure adequate time left for setting up.
Injury through lack of supervision	Fully trained staff must be present with equipment throughout set up and collection. Staff member to brief customer on best safety practices throughout hire to minimise injury.	1	4	4	N/A
Equipment falling over	All equipment to be secured down with heavy weights to prevent falling.	1	2	2	N/A
